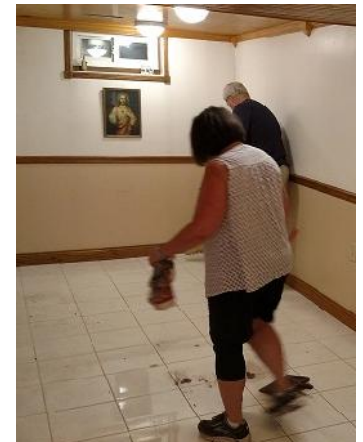
The moving crew cleared out a room next to the current engineering and programming location to make room for broadcast studio.

DR. TAYLOR MARSHALL JOINS KCRD 98.3 BROADCAST LINE-UP

Dr. Taylor Marshall was an Episcopal priest in Fort Worth, Texas before being received with his wife into the Catholic Church by Bishop Kevin Vann of Fort Worth on May 23, 2006. He has since become the best-selling Catholic author of *The Crucified Rabbi*, *The Eternal City*; *Sword and Serpent*. His most recent, *Infiltration: The Plot to Destroy the Church From Within*, has just been released.

Dr. Marshall's podcasts will air on KCRD on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday evenings at 7:00 pm. (See note on back page regarding Friday changes due to Notre Dame Football contractual obligations.)

He has appeared on EWTN's The Journey Home with Marcus Grodi, Catholic Answers Live, Al Kresta in the Afternoon, Deep in Scripture, Immaculate Heart Radio, Son Rise Morning Show, and been a guest on multiple cable and network news programs.

His website receives over 2.6 million visits per year with over 200,000 total subscribers. He launched the New Saint Thomas Institute in 2013 to bring advanced, fun, and affordable theology classes to all six inhabited continents, 60 nations and over 3,000 students.

Dr. Marshall and his wife Joy make their home in Colleyville, Texas with their eight children.
